# Gulf Coast Apostolic Youth Camp Camper Rules and Regulations

### **ALL CAMPERS:**

- 1. Must attend all activities in the Sanctuary.
- 2. Must not leave dorms from lights out until 7 A.M. without permission from Dorm Supervisor.
- 3. May not leave campgrounds without permission from the Principal.
- 4. No pairing off of boys with girls. No holding hands, kissing, or necking.
- 5. No boys allowed in girls dorms. No girls allowed in boys dorms.
- 6. No hitting, kicking, or fighting.
- 7. No worldly music, knives, cigarette lighters, or suggestive slogans on clothes.
- 8. No damage to or altering of camp property or facilities, supplies, or products. All costs of repairs shall be at your expense and you will be sent home.
- 9. Must respectfully obey all requests and orders of camp staff at all times.
- 10. No stealing or damaging personal belongings of campers.
- 11. Cell phones and cameras are not to be used in the dormitories.
- 12. Swim attire to consist of shirts with sleeves, pants or skirts below the knee. No denim or clothes with zippers.

## \*\*Girls Only

- 1. Skirt length must be below the knee at all times.
- 2. Sleeves must be below the elbow.
- 3. No visible leggings under skirts (leggings must be shorter than the skirt)
- 4. No shorts or pants.
- 5. No tight or sheer clothing.
- 6. No low necklines.
- 7. No belly-button shirts.
- 8. No jewelry.
- 9. No makeup of any kind or nail polish.
- 10. Hosiery must be worn to Evening Services.
- 11. Dress attire at Evening Services

## \*\*Boys Only

- 1. No shorts.
- 2. No jewelry.
- 3. Senior Youth Campers sleeves must be below the elbow
- 4. No tight or sheer clothing.
- 5. Clean-shaven.
- 6. No belly-button shirts.
- 7. Dress attire at evening services.

#### \*\*ABC Campground Restrictions

- 1. Food or cold drinks **ABSOLUTELY NOT ALLOWED IN CHAPEL** or **DORMITORIES**. Attendees are to use ABC snack facilities and not bring their own.
- 2. No cooking allowed in dormitories.
- 3. All vehicles must remain parked and unoccupied upon arrival at camp. No sitting on or riding on outside of vehicles.
- 4. NO FIREWORKS, FIREARMS, LOUD MUSIC, CURSING or GAMBLING allowed on grounds. NO SHAVING CREAM FIGHTS or WATER BALLOON FIGHTS.
- 5. NO RIP STICKS, SKATEBOARDS OR SKATES ALLOWED.
- 6. ALL MEDICINES (prescription, non-prescription, herbs, vitamins, etc.) MUST BE IN

ORIGINAL CONTAINER and MUST BE GIVEN TO COUNSELOR at onset of camp. Any camper caught with unreported medications may be sent home immediately with no refund.
